PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

Stage One: The first six weeks comprises a taught term, where you will study at the beautiful Regent's campus in the royal Regent's Park or in fashionable Marylebone Village. You will take two fashion modules with industry-practitioner tutors while experiencing study trips to fashion and other venues in London. The two modules are worth 24 UK credits, equivalent to 6 US credits. For details of the modules available, visit regents.ac.uk/summer

Stage Two: A taught term with a six-week, credit-bearing Internship in central London. Students who successfully complete the Internship will be awarded 20 UK credits, equivalent to 5 US credits. The Internship involves work in industry (with a maximum of 35 hours per week), weekly face-to-face tutorials with a Regent's tutor and assessments: reflective log and a final report, which you will complete with support from your tutor.

general tasks involve assisting during factory
visits and helping backstage (or preparing for)
London Fashion Week.

Human Resources and Merchandising

for Global Fashion Label This is a womenswear clothing label that embraces a global approach to fashion, with creative, contemporary silhouettes, vibrant prints, and complimentary collections from New European Designers. The intern will be involved in a variety of departments including HR, Retail, Merchandising and Business Development. Educational backgrounds of interns can be diverse provided the individual is interested in learning and willing to engage with all staff and prepare.

Fashion Buying, Merchandising, Styling and Event Planning This showroom receives collections and creates campaigns for well-known brands. The intern will sell brands from the showroom to buyers and reach out to potential buyers to secure future partnerships with companies from all over the world. Other tasks may include coordinating casting calls, styling models, visual merchandising around the showroom, and organizing fashion shows and related events. Those with confidence in their knowledge of the fashion industry and an outgoing personality will shine in this role.

Please note that students participating in the Fashion Programme with Internship will need to apply for a <u>Tier 4 visa</u>. It is important that you speak to your home academic advisor if you wish to explore this opportunity.

Tuition

Programme Fee: £7200*

*Please note that a limited number of internship places are available. If you decide to apply please note that you will be required to make a non-refundable deposit of a £2100 towards the programme fee.

*Please note that each fashion module (taken in the first 6 weeks of the programme) will incur an additional charge of £150 to cover mandatory resources i.e. fashion exhibitions, fashion events, photography shoots, and course materials.

Accommodation
