Visiting Regent's University London

Alumni of Regent's University London are welcome to enter the University during the normal visitor hours – 9am to 5pm, Monday to Sunday.

Entry and Alumni Access Card

Upon arrival, initial entry is only via the main front reception. You may exit through the back gate.

Please present your Alumni Access Card, as this is official proof of your alumni status and entry onto the campus. The card must be carried at all times during your visit at the University.

What to do if you have an existing access letter:

- Prior to your visit, please contact alumni@regents.ac.uk or fill out the online form: <https://www.regents.ac.uk/alumni-access-card-registration>
- If you are at the university with an existing access letter, it is still valid during your visit, but we encourage you to apply for a card. Security will contact the Development & Alumni Relations Office to help process a new card.
- If you do not have a letter or card, security will contact the Development & Alumni Relations Office to help process a new card.

This card will be valid for one year and will need to be renewed once expired. Please contact alumni@regents.ac.uk prior to expiry to renew. If on campus, this can be updated through Security.

The alumni card will only allow entry for the name and photographed alumnus/-a. Any visitors accompanying the alumnus/-a will need to be signed in. The alumnus/-a will act as a representative.

Continued use of on-campus resources

Regent's alumni are entitled to a number of benefits and on-campus resources, including:

- access to the campus, using the Alumni Access Card
- use of publicly available spaces, such as the quad, refectory and brasserie, seating spaces and nearby sockets for laptops, phones etc
- use of a computer in the IT Centre for web browsing
- use of a computer in the IT Centre for word processing, spreadsheets, presentations (anything that can be done using MS Office)
- independent library study
- reference-only access to library books and journals

Important: no file space on the network will be allocated; no Regent's email will be given; the University gives priority to current registered students using University learning resources and therefore reserves the right to restrict access to alumni on occasions when this additional demand could compromise the experience of current students.

The above benefits and on-campus resources are a lifelong offer to Regent's alumni.

Lifelong support for alumni
