

# Our Phased Return to Regent's

Regent's is implementing a five-level, phased approach to our return to campus. The levels outline what the University will be able to facilitate or provide, subject to Government guidance. We will only proceed to the next phase of further activity if we are confident that doing so will not compromise the health and safety of our students, staff and visitors.
