

# Admission to Programmes for September 2021 and Subsequent Intakes

#### The Admissions of Students to an Integrated Foundation Programme (sponsored at Level 6)

The minimum entry requirement for Level 3 students is:

- > one of the following qualifications:
- 5 GCSEs at grade A-C or equivalent
- US High School Diploma with a minimum GPA of 2.5
- Equivalent qualifications as deemed acceptable by the University and set out in the Admissions Guide and UK NARIC
- Applicants who do not meet our A-Level/International Baccalaureate requirements will be considered for the level 3 programme
- minimum English language proficiency requirement through one of the following qualifications (or equivalent):

#### Admissions of Students to an Undergraduate Programme at Level 4

## **BAM/Liberal Studies/BSc Psychology**

The minimum entry requirement for Level 4 students is:

- > one of the following qualifications:
- Three GCE A-levels at grade A-C
- 24 points in the International Baccalaureate
- A minimum GPA of 2.5 PLUS one of the following (applicants with a very strong GPA can be academically referred at the AO's discretion):
  - three AP tests with an average grade of 3 or two AP tests with an average grade of 4
  - three SAT II (Subject Tests) with a minimum score of 500 in each section or two SAT II with a minimum score of 600 in each section
  - SAT I (Reasoning Tests) with a minimum score of 1800 (600 in each section)
  - ACT with a composite score of 26 (20 in each section)
  - Dual Enrolment and College credits (1st Year) 30 credits with a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Equivalent qualifications as deemed acceptable by the University and set out in the Admissions Guide and UK NARIC
- minimum Maths requirement through one of the following qualifications (or equivalent): only applicable for Business and Management, BSc Psychology and Liberal Studies (Business & Management) courses:

The minimum entry requirement for Level 4 students is:

- > one of the following qualifications:
- Two GCE A-levels at grade A-C
- 24 points in the International Baccalaureate
- US High School Diploma with a minimum GPA of 2.5 PLUS one of the following (applicants with a very strong GPA can be academically referred at the AOI's discretion):
  - two AP tests with an average grade of 3
  - two SAT II (Subject Tests) with a minimum score of 500 in each section
  - SAT I (Reasoning Tests) with a minimum score of 1650 (550 in each section)
  - ACT with a composite score of 23 (20 in each section)
  - Dual Enrolment and College credits (1st Year) 20 credits with a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- Equivalent qualifications as deemed acceptable by the University and set out in the Admissions Manual and UK NARIC
- > minimum English language proficiency requirement through one of the following qualifications (or equivalent):

## Admissions of Students to a Postgraduate Programme at Level 7

The minimum entry requirement for Level 7 students is:

- > one of the following qualifications:
  - Minimum second class UK undergraduate degree
  - Equivalent international qualifications as deemed acceptable by Admissions and UKNARIC
  - Exceptional entry will be assessed on case by case basis by academic referral only based on:
    - an undergraduate degree lower than 2:2 plus one year of relevant work experience
    - no Level 6 qualifications but three years of relevant work experience
