


Welcome to Regent's University London








Our secure campus is set in a quiet, leafy park in the centre of London. Set in 11 acres of private garden, it's a safe respite, with gated access and 24/7 security.


Mixing with almost 3,000 international students on campus, you'll never be just another face in the crowd. You'll make international friends, learn about other cultures and build a global network for your future.

Accommodation

No matter how long you study with us, we have a range of accommodation options for you.

Homestay accommodation

Experience a British way of life while you study. Private and homestay accommodation options are available throughout London, organised by experienced external providers. They are conveniently located and close to public transport. You can socialise and eat with your host, giving you the chance to practise your English outside the classroom. Hosts are selected for their friendliness and homes must meet British Council and English UK standards.

On-campus accommodation during the Summer

Reid Hall is located on our campus in Regent's Park overlooking the surrounding gardens. Living on campus allows you to relax and socialise, while being just moments away from the classroom and campus facilities.

Each floor has three communal bathrooms (with around five students per bathroom) and, while the rooms include meal credit to be used in the University's range of dining outlets, there is also a pantry on each floor, providing you with access to a microwave, kettle and sink.

Pre-sessional Course

Monday - Thursday 09:15-12:30 and 13:30-15:00 and Friday 09:15-12:30 21 hours per week

This course is designed for students who currently hold an offer for a degree programme at Regent's University London. The course is available at various lengths, depending on the student's level of English and the entry requirements of their chosen degree programme.

At the initial stage of the course students attend Intensive English classes and in the last 12 weeks, the course consists of General English in the mornings with Academic English and REPT (Regent's English Proficiency Test) exam preparation in the afternoons.

Students take two mock exams throughout the course and the final exam in the last week. Upon successful completion, students can progress directly to their chosen degree programme at Regent's, provided they have met the entry requirements.

General English plus IELTS

Monday to Thursday 09:15 – 15:00 Friday 09:15 – 12:30

21 hours per week

This course is designed to develop the English language skills and exam techniques that you need to be successful in your IELTS exam.

General English lessons in the mornings will improve your confidence and boost your fluency when communicating in English.

Our experienced teachers will focus on improving your speaking, writing, listening and reading skills while covering various grammar structures, formal and informal vocabulary and pronunciation.

In the afternoons you'll learn the exam techniques, strategies and how to complete reading, listening, speaking and writing tasks successfully.

The minimum level of English proficiency required is Intermediate. If you are aiming for a band 7 or higher you should ideally be at Upper Intermediate level (B2/B2+).

■ General English

The General English course in the mornings covers all language skills (reading, writing, listening, speaking) as well as grammar, vocabulary and pronunciation.

The course will help to boost your confidence and improve your fluency when speaking English.

Classes are interactive, engaging and flexible, with a clear focus on meaningful and developmental activities which promote language learning in the context of the classroom and beyond – tailored to your individual strengths, weaknesses and needs.

■ Business and Employability Skills

(13:30 - 15:00 twice a week)

These sessions will help you to develop the skills needed to communicate effectively and confidently in the modern workplace. They are ideal for individuals who are at an early stage in their career, preparing for a career change or aiming to find a job in an English-speaking workplace. Workshops cover how to succeed with job applications and interviews, effective workplace communication and vocabulary and grammar for business situations.

■ Sightseeing in London

(13:30 - 16:30 twice a week)

Our tours and trips will enable you to explore both famous sights and hidden gems in London. You'll learn about British culture, customs, traditions and history while practising speaking English with your fellow students. This option will give you a perfect balance of academic, cultural and social experience.

Students on courses of four weeks or longer can select to follow more than one afternoon option. All students take a placement test and are placed in a General English class according to their level of English – minimum Pre-Intermediate (A2).

Practical learning


Practise your English language skills in class, around campus and throughout London.
