# A legacy of excellence

For over 170 years, our campus has been a beacon of learning - fostering talent and challenging conventions.

1900s



The University campus was originally built as the site for Bedford College, which pioneered female education at a time when such opportunities were scarce.

This groundbreaking institution offered an innovative curriculum, challenging societal norms and paving the way for future generations.

1980s



In 1984, Rockford College, renowned for its innovative study abroad programmes, acquired the site and established Regent's College. This merger enriched the campus with a diverse, international perspective - fostering a truly global learning environment.

2000s



Regent's College merged with esteemed institutions like the European Business School and the School of Psychotherapy & Counselling and launched experimental courses in film, media, fashion and design.

In 2013, it was awarded university status and changed its name to Regent's University London.

2020s



In 2020, the University joined Galileo Global Education (a leading provider of higher education) and launched an revolutionary new curriculum integrating industry and entrepreneurship skills, preparing and empowering students for success in a rapidly changing world.

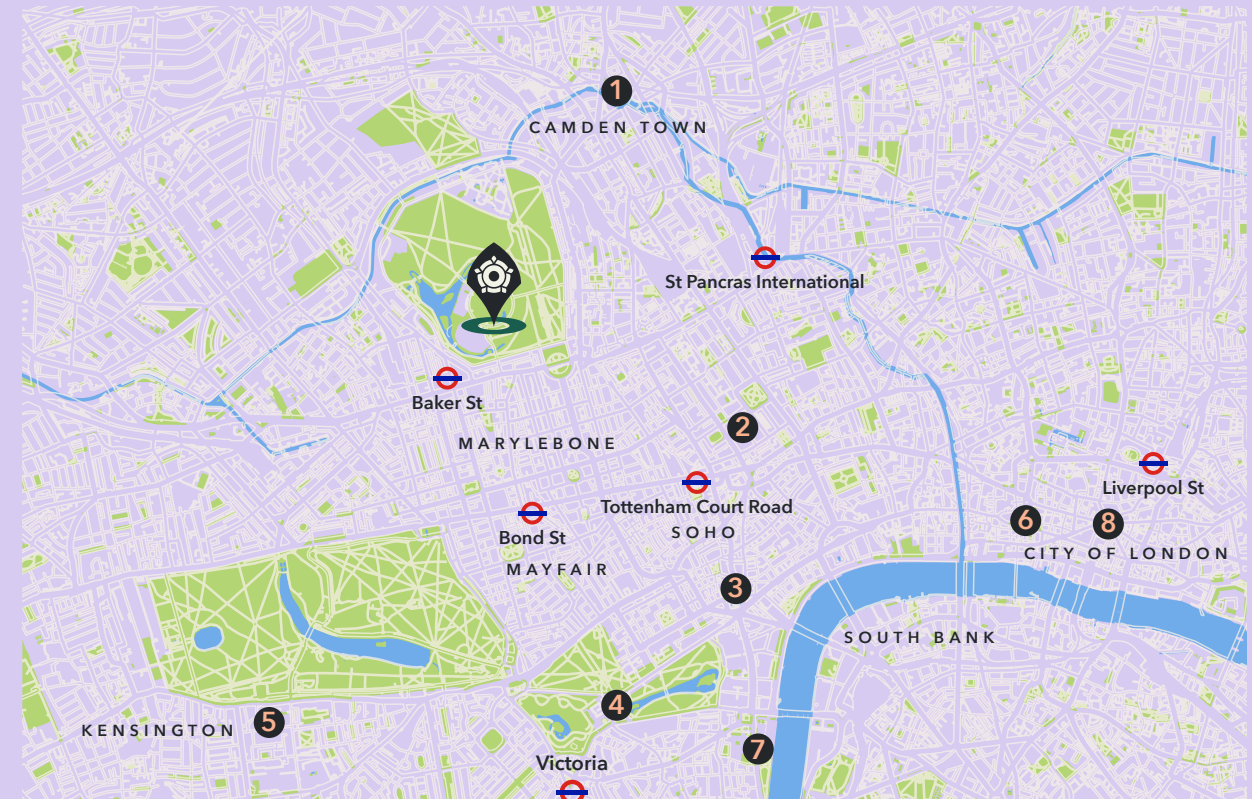

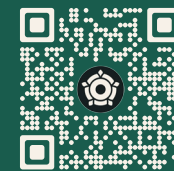

# Psychology, Psychotherapy & Counselling

Regent's is a leading institution for psychology, psychotherapy and counselling, and offers a smooth training route from foundation all the way through to postgraduate and professional qualification.

Discover vastly different ideas and concepts, from traditional science to philosophy, and learn to make sense of how people think, feel and interact with the world around them.

This year, psychology students visited the Freud Museum and Bethlem Museum of the Mind and heard personal stories from speakers including forensic psychologists, international artists and those who struggle with complex mental health conditions. Psychotherapy students were invited to an intimate lecture with Integrative Psychotherapist, Dwight Turner, took part in clinical placements (from research agencies to the NHS) and engaged in weekly psychotherapy sessions.

# Acting and Film

Connect with a creative community of filmmakers, screenwriters and actors - exploring how stories are told through performance and how to take a production from script to stage.

You'll work side-by-side with leading directors, writers, producers and actors who have worked on Oscar-nominated films, award-winning documentaries and five-star theatre productions.

Recently, students visited the Young Vic to watch *Untitled F\*ck M\*ss S\*\*gon Play* - a powerful new satire that debunks racial stereotypes in musicals such as *Miss Saigon*, *South Pacific* and *Madam Butterfly*. After the show, they were treated to a private Q&A with the director (Roy Alexander Weise), lead actor (Olivier Award nominee, Mei Mac) and production staff - learning how to use voice and movement to bring characters to life.
