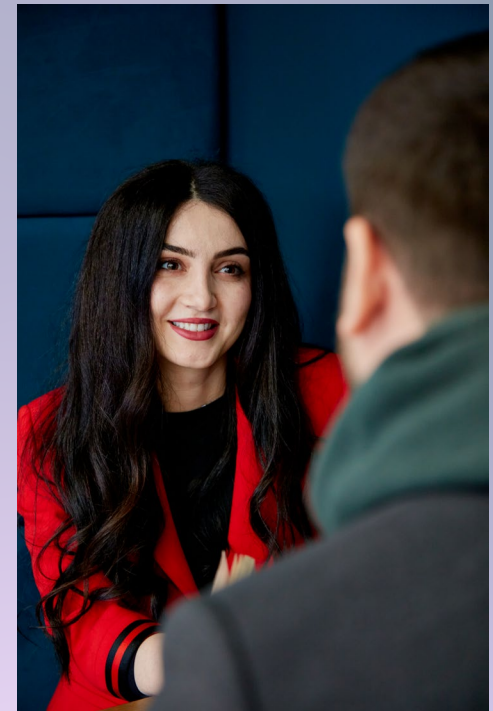
Download your files:

Your Regent's email account, OneDrive and Blackboard access will expire within one year of your last day of term, so make sure you download and save any important emails, documents and files to a personal device before your access ends

Check your contact details:

The personal email address stored in e-Vision will become our primary way of contacting you after graduation, so make sure it's up to date.



Student visa holders

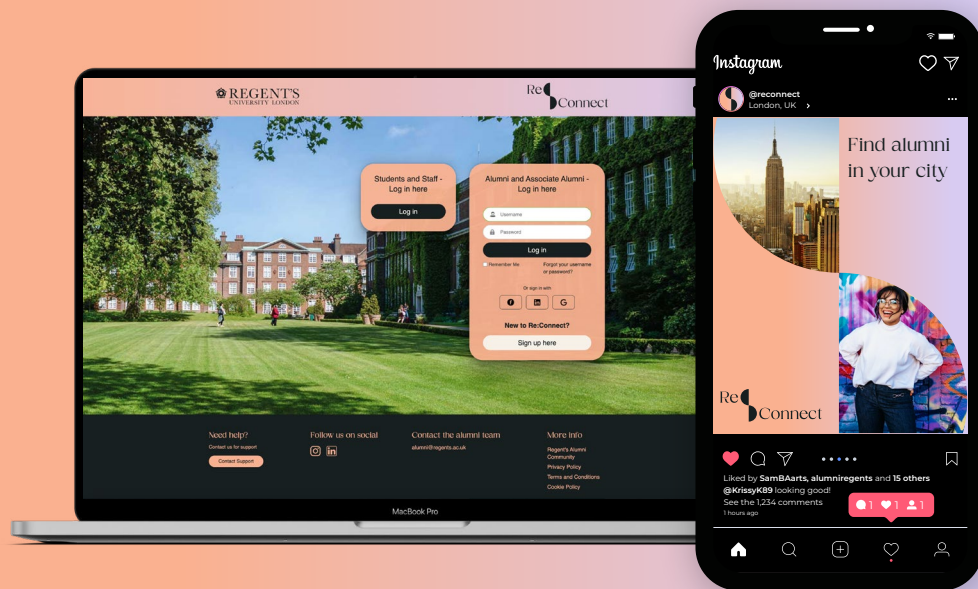
While you're in the UK and your Student visa is still valid, you may be able to apply for a visa under the Graduate Immigration Route. The Graduate visa is a scheme which allows recent graduates to stay in the UK for a period of at least 18 months to work or seek employment.
